

Cross-County Pipeline - Sec.15 of 27 (/initiative/4XwK/cross-county-pipeline---sec15-of-27)

At ~500' elevation, the Cross-County Pipeline conveys <6000 AFY of raw water to Loch Lomond from some or all streams between the San Lorenzo River and Soquel Creek, inclusive, possibly also Bear Creek and Aptos Creek. It also could augment any of 9 streams when needed for fish habitat. Fish-friendly diversion devices would inherently filter out turbidity. The Pipeline would store winter water in Loch Lomond, then distribute Loch water throughout the year to water districts, who would rest wells to recharge aquifers extremely quickly. The vast recharged aquifers would robustly protect all mid-County. Costs: see Section 7e.
